

Free-Standing Christmas Decoration

Embroidery

Instructions

Gingerbread Man

1. Hoop wash away stabilizer in the hoop that suits the size of the embroidery design.
2. Load the design into the sew out screen of the embroidery machine.
3. Thread the machine with bobbinfil in the bobbin and embroidery thread in the top.
4. Sew out colour 1. This is the placement line for the fabric.
5. Lay the fabric right side up over the stitch line.
6. Thread the machine with a similar colour to the fabric.
7. Sew out colour 2. This is the seam line of the fabric.
8. Trim the fabric back to the edge of the stitch line.
9. Leave the machine threaded with this colour and sew out colour 3 the fabric tack down stitch along the cut edge.
10. Thread the machine with the colour that you wish for the eyes to be. Sew out colour 4.
11. Thread the machine with the colour that you wish for the bowtie and mouth to be. Sew out colour 5.
12. Thread the machine with the colour that you wish for the arm and leg details to be. Sew out colour 6.
13. Thread the machine with the colour that you wish for the buttons to be. Sew out colour 7.
14. Thread the machine with the colour that you wish for the satin stitch to be. At this point you will need to change the bobbin thread to match the top thread.
15. Lay a backing fabric on the back of the hoop. The machine will sew out the tack down stitch. Sew out colour 8.
16. Remove the hoop from the machine and trim the fabric from the back.
17. Attach the hoop to the machine again.
18. Thread the machine for the final step being the satin stitch around the edge of the gingerbread man.
19. Remove from the hoop and trim away excess stabilizer then rinse.
20. You may wish to hang the decoration so at this point you can sew a small ribbon onto the back.



Requirements

- Embroidery Machine
- Hoop to suit design size
- Design Downloaded
- Transfer device, e.g. USB stick or iPad
- Assorted Fabric for the decorations
- Wash away stabilizer to fit hoop
- Assorted embroidery threads to decorate and construct the embroidery.
- Bobbinfil on bobbins
- Ribbon
- Scissors
- Snips
- Quick Unpick

Christmas Pudding

1. Hoop wash away stabilizer in the hoop that suits the size of the embroidery design.
2. Load the design into the sew out screen of the embroidery machine.
3. Thread the machine with bobbinfil in the bobbin and embroidery thread in the top.
4. Sew out colour 1. This is the placement line for the fabric.
5. Lay the fabric right side up over the stitch line.
6. Thread the machine with a similar colour to the fabric.
7. Sew out colour 2. This is the seam line of the fabric.
8. Trim the fabric back to the edge of the stitch line.
9. Thread the machine with the colour that you wish for the lower half of the pudding to be. Sew out colour 3.
10. Thread the machine with the colour that you wish for the icing of the pudding to be. Sew out colour 4. This will be the fabric placement line.
11. Lay the fabric over the icing section and sew out colour 5.
12. Trim the fabric back to the stitch line and sew out the fabric tack down. Sew out colour 6
13. While the machine is still threaded in the colour for the icing sew out the satin stitch around the icing. Sew colour 7.
14. Thread the machine with the colour that you wish for the leaves to be. Sew out colour 8.
15. Thread the machine with the colour that you wish for the cherries to be. Sew out colour 9.
16. Thread the machine with the colour that you wish for the satin stitch to be. At this point you will need to change the bobbin thread to match the top thread
17. Lay a backing fabric on the back of the hoop. The machine will sew out the tack down stitch. Sew out colour 10.
18. Remove the hoop from the machine and trim the fabric from the back.
19. Attach the hoop to the machine again.
20. Thread the machine for the final step being the satin stitch around the edge of the pudding.
21. Remove from the hoop and trim away excess stabilizer then rinse.
22. You may wish to hang the decoration so at this point you can sew a small ribbon onto the back.



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
