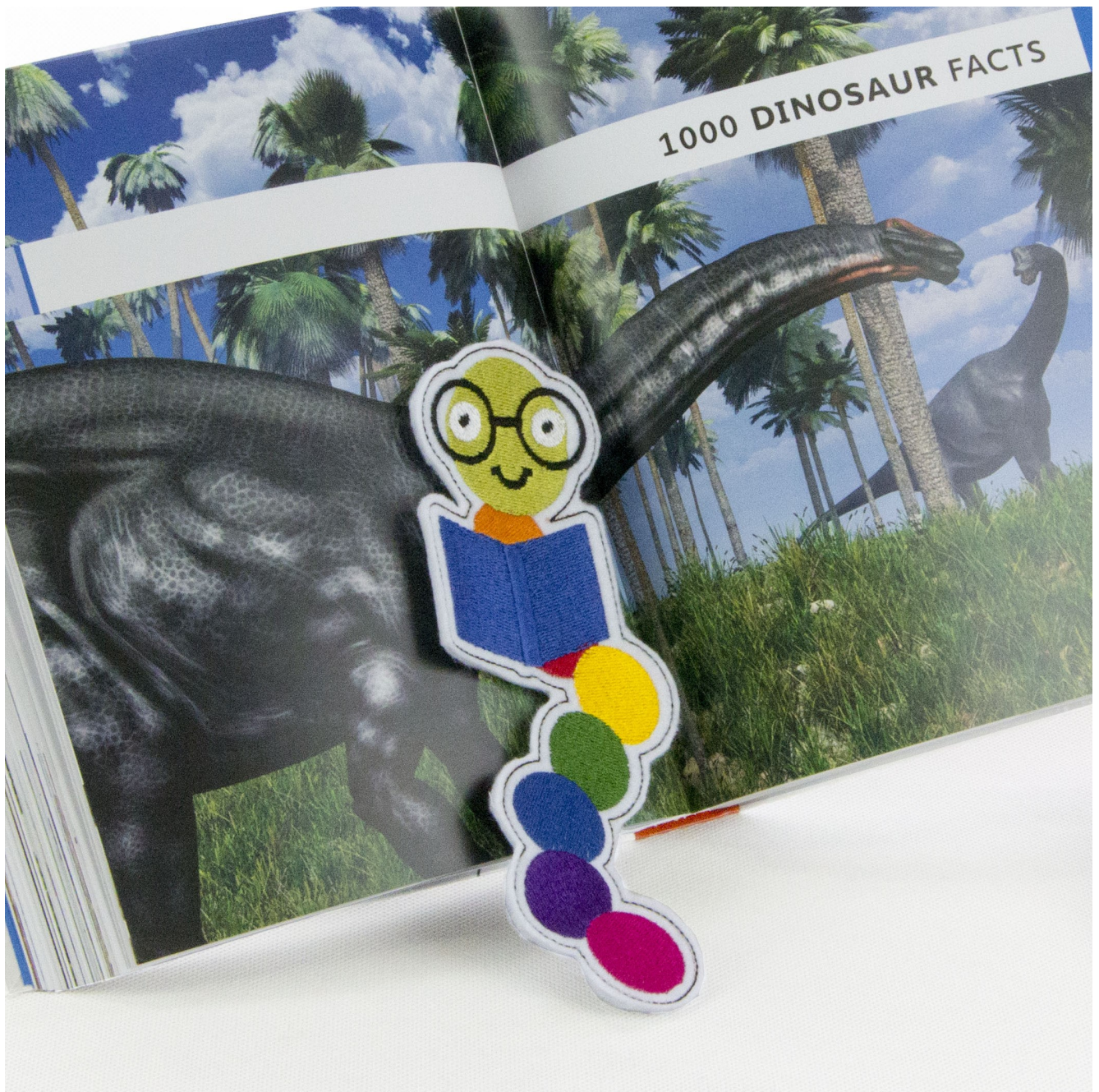

Janome Embroidery Bookworm Bookmark

Janome Embroidery Bookworm Bookmark

Requirements:

- (2) x 3 1/2" x 8" pieces of felt
- Assortment of embroidery threads.
- (We used 10 colours to complete the sample in a rainbow of colours.)
- Bobbinfil on a bobbin
- Empty bobbin to wind with matching thread
- Tearaway to fit selected hoop for your machine
- USB or device to transfer embroidery design

Instructions:

1. Transfer design to the media your Janome machine uses.
2. Open the design on the machine. (If you wish to do more than one in a hooping copy the design now.)
3. Hoop the size hoop required to sew the bookmark with tearaway stabilizer. (1 bookmark = 67mm x 178mm)
4. Thread the machine with a thread that matches the felt you are using.
5. Sew out the first placement line. | Figure A
6. Lay the felt over the placement line. Be sure to cover all of the previous stitching.
7. Sew out the holding stitch. | Figure B
8. Thread the machine with orange thread. Sew out the first circle below the head. | Figure C
9. Thread the machine with red thread. Sew out the first circle below the book. | Figure D
10. Thread the machine with yellow thread. Sew the next circle for the body. | Figure E
11. Thread the machine with green thread. Sew the next circle for the body. | Figure F
12. Thread the machine with blue thread. Sew the next circle and the book. | Figure G
13. Thread the machine with purple thread. Sew the next circle for the body. | Figure H
14. Thread the machine with pink thread. Sew the last circle for the body. | Figure I
15. Thread the machine with light green thread. Sew the main colour for the head. | Figure J
16. Thread the machine with white thread. Sew out the large section of the eyes. | Figure K
17. Thread the machine with black thread. Sew out the centres of the eyes, the glasses and the mouth. | Figure L
18. The next step is to attach a backing before the book mark can be completed.
19. Thread the machine with a thread that you wish to sew around the edge. Ensure that you also use a bobbin of the same colour so that the front and back match when completed. | Figure M
20. Remove the hoop from the machine. Spray the backing piece of felt with a small amount of adhesive or use a fabric glue pen. Place over the shape of the bookworm to ensure that all the stitching is covered. Attach the hoop to the machine.
21. Sew out the outline stitch around the bookworm. | Figure N
22. Remove from the hoop and cut back to the desired width from the stitching.
23. Your bookmark is now ready for all the books you wish to read.

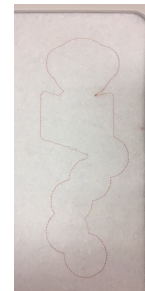

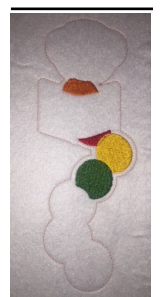
