**Sliding Guide Foot** 





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• <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" sewing foot Requirements • Ruler, rotary cutter, mat • Janome Sewing Machine • Scissors and snips • Sliding Glide Foot • Tape measure • Selection of fabrics x WOF for strips • Pins / quilting clips Scraps of fabric for smaller sections • Seam Ripper • 70cm x WOF for the backing • Iron and Ironing board • 21" x 43" wadding Construction and decorative threads . . . . . . . . . .

### Instructions:

Working from top to bottom on the layout diagram below cut and sew using 1/4'' seams.

- 1. First sew the strips with piecing together to create long strips.
- 2. Press seams then sew the rows together to create the runner.
- 3. Press all seams using the iron.
- Trim the runner length to 42'' long. 4.

Follow on to the next page for the next steps to embellish and complete the runner

# FESTIVE TABLE RUNNER

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
#### **Sliding Guide Foot**

## Instructions:

- 1. Lay out the backing fabric with the right side of the fabric against the table surface.
- 2. Centre the wadding on top of the backing.
- Lay the pieced runner right side up on top of the wadding so that there is about ½'' of wadding showing on each side of the runner top. | Figure A
- 4. Start with one side and fold the raw edge into the edge of the wadding. | Figure B
- 5. Then fold the folded edge onto the front of the runner. | Figure C
- 6. At the corner fold the corner down the edge of the next side in line with the edge of the runner. | Figure D
- 7. Then fold the raw edge of this side in to the edge of the wadding. | Figure E
- Then fold this edge over onto the front of the runner to create the mitred corner. | Figure F
- 9. Continue this process around all the edges of the runner pinning as you go.
- 10. Thread the machine with matching thread in the top and bobbin.
- 11. Select a decorative stitch to sew around the binding.
- 12. Attach the sliding guide foot to the machine.

(Note: The packaging for this foot has the widths that match to the markings on the arm of the foot for easy reference.)

- Set the gauge on the foot to the required width for your binding. For our sample this was at 5/8'' marking. | Figure G
- Line up the outer edge of the binding with the gauge and then sew around the four sides of the binding. | Figure H & I
- Continue to reset the width of the foot to create more rows of decorative stitching should you wish to embellish the middle of the runner. | Figure J
