

## Embroidery: Editing on the Machine Project – Dreamcatcher

### Requirements:

- MC15000 machine & embroidery unit
- Red or Yellow dot bobbin cases
- SQ23 hoop
- Embroidery foot P
- Straight stitch plate
- Blue tip needles
- 2 bobbins pre-wound with bobbin fill thread
- Selection of embroidery threads: 7-10 reels consisting of 3 different but co-ordinating colours in a few shades of each colour (ie: light, medium & dark)
- One piece of plain cotton fabric approx. 40 x 40cm
- One piece of stabiliser 40 x 40cm



### Instructions:

#### Embroidery Design

1. With the machine turned off, attach the embroidery unit, embroidery foot P, blue tip needle and straight stitch needle plate.  
Change to the Yellow dot bobbin case if NOT using Janome bobbin fill

2. Turn on the machine and press the [Mode switch key] to switch to embroidery mode  
Follow the directions on the screen



3. Press the [Editing mode key] to open the embroidery editing screen



4. Press the [Home key] and then the [Built-in design key]  
*The default category is the 'World of Embroidery Designs'*



5. Press the [Design category key]



6. Using the up/down arrows on the right, scroll to page 2 and select the Abstract Designs category



7. On page 2, select the circular design #24



8. Press the [Rotate key]



9. Rotate the design to 315° by pressing the anti-clockwise [45° key] once  
Press [OK]



10. Press the [Home key] [Built-in design key] [Design category key]  
On page 4, select the Fringe design category



11. On page 3, select the fringe designs #4



12. Press the [Home key] [Built-in design key] select fringe design #5  
*Notice it opens to the folder/page you were last on*



13. Select design #4 by using the [Pattern selection keys]  
Press the [+] or [-] keys until #4 fringe has a red square around it then press the [Heart key] to select that design



*The square around the design will turn green*

14. Position fringe design #4 below design #24  
Using the stylus and/or the [layout keys]



15. Position fringe design #5 inside the large circle of design #24 and press the [Resize key]



16. Increase size to 110% by pressing the [+] key ten times  
Press [OK]



17. Duplicate design #5 by pressing the [Duplicate key]



18. Position the second design #5 to left of design #24 and decrease the size to 80%  
Press [OK]

## Adding Text

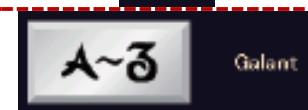
19. Press the [Monogramming key]



20. Press the [Font selection key]  
*The default font is Gothic*



21. On page 1, select the Galant Font



22. Press the [Letter size key] twice to change the size to Large  
*The default size is medium*



23. Type the letter 'D'  
Press the [Letter case key] to change to lower case  
Type the letters 'ream'  
Press [OK]



24. Press the [Rotate key]



25. Rotate the design to 50° by pressing the clockwise [45° key] once and the [1° key] five times



26. Position the word 'Dream' towards the top-right of the medium circle in design #24

27. Press the [Arc key]



28. Press the [Upper arc key] five times



29. Press the [Enlarge key] once  
Press [OK]



30. Press the [Zoom key]



31. Select the [Largest zoom size key]

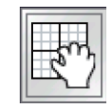
*Two levels of zoom are available only in the MC15000 Version 3  
One level of zoom is available in the MC15000 Version 1 & 2*



32. Move the design in the window so you can see the word 'Dream'

Press the [Scroll key] to cancel the scroll command

*By default it is turned on and has a black background, when turned off it has a light grey background*



33. Fine tune the position of the text using the [Layout keys] so that the space between the circle and the text is even



34. Press the [Scroll key] to turn the scroll command on and move the design so you can view the fringe design inside the large circle

Press the [Scroll key] to turn off

35. Fine tune the position of the fringe design so that the space around it is even



36. Press the [Zoom key] and select the [Normal view size key] to return to the normal editing screen

37. Press the [Group key] to open the grouping option window

*The background will turn black when selected*



38. Press the [Group all] key

Press [OK]



39. Move the design into the centre of the editing screen

Press the [Group all] key to ungroup the designs

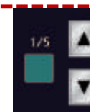
*The background will turn light grey*

## Customising Display Colours

40. Select the Abstract circle design and Press the [Custom colour key]



41. Scroll to the colour you wish to change



42. Select the hue by pressing one of the [Colour tile keys]



43. Adjust the shade by pressing the [Slider keys] lighter or darker



44. Scroll to the next colour and re-colour as above

Once all colours have been changed in the design, press OK

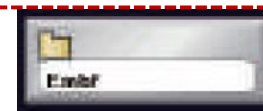
45. Select one of the Fringe designs and repeat if desired

## Saving the Design

46. Press the [Save file key]



47. Press the 'Embf' folder



48. Press the [New folder key]



49. Name the folder 'SweetDream' and press [OK] to create the new folder

*Folder & file names can be 10 characters maximum*

50. Press the [Rename key]



51. Name the design 'Dream\_1' and press [OK]

*Use the [Change case key] to toggle between upper & lowercase letters*

52. Select the new 'SweetDream' folder and press [OK] to save the design
