

### WHAT YOU WILL NEED

Janome Sewing Machine (we used DC6050)  
Even Feed Foot (open-toe) and guide  
Satin Stitch Foot **F**  
Janome Purple Tip Needle Size 14  
Reel of Janome Metallic Thread - Silver Grey (M220)  
Reel of Janome Bobbinfil  
3 x Janome Plastic Bobbin  
Thread Snips / Scissor  
Dressmaking Pins or Wonder Clips  
Fabric erasable pen or chalk pen  
Cutting mat / Rotary cutter / Ruler  
Tape measure  
Ironing board and iron

### FABRIC & NOTIONS

1 x Fat Quarter (*main fabric*)  
1 x Fat Quarter (*lining*)  
Fabric strip for binding  
Iron-on batting  
1 x Reel sewing thread to suit your fabric  
1 x Reel sewing thread to match binding fabric  
50cm x Fluted ribbon 25mm (optional)

### CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

#### Main Fabric

Cut 2 pieces L7" x W8" (18 x 20½cm)

#### Lining Fabric - pink bucket

Cut 1 piece L14" x W8" (38 x 20½cm)

#### Lining Fabric - green bucket

Cut 1 piece L18" x W8" (46 x 20½cm)

#### Iron-on batting

Cut 2 pieces L6½" x W7½" (16½ x 19cm)

#### Pink Binding

Cut 1 strip on the bias W4½" x L15½" (11½ x 38cm)

#### Fluted ribbon (optional)

Cut only when you are ready to use.



### INSTRUCTIONS

**PINK BUCKET** (*green bucket instructions on page 3*)

#### Step 1

Take the 2 main fabric pieces, on the wrong side of the fabric position the iron-on batting, make sure you can see a ¼" (6mm) of the main fabric around the edges of the batting. Press.

*Tip: when pressing iron-on batting, use an applique mat, on the batting. Alternatively, turn the fabric right side up (batting underneath) and press by placing and holding the iron for a few moments then lift and re-position, until adhered to fabric.*

#### Step 2 Decorative Stitching

Thread the machine with the Janome Metallic Thread and Janome bobbinfil on bobbin.

Attach the Satin Stitch Foot **F**

Select a decorative stitch, we used #39 \*

Set foot pressure to 4.


Stitch down the length in rows one inch apart.

Mark lines if required.



### Step 3

Attach the Even Feed Foot

Select Stitch #16 

Foot pressure: 5

Stitch rows in between previously sewn rows.



### Step 4

Select straight stitch L: default W: 7

Place 2 main fabrics right sides together and stitch side seams. Line up the edge of the fabric with the edge of the foot.

### Step 5 Lining

Take the lining fabric, fold in half the length in half and sewing the side seams, the same as in Step 4.

### Step 6

Take the main fabric and lining pieces. From the bottom corners mark  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " (4cm) up the each side seam, then measure and mark the same distance in from the each side seam. Cut out the corners, as shown below.

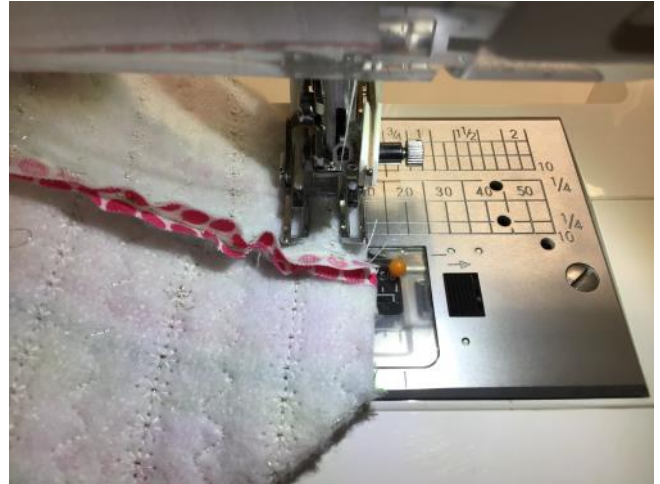


### Step 7

Stitch the bottom seam on the main fabric.

### Step 8

Open out the corners on the main fabric and the lining fabric. Pin together, then stitch the seam to form a base for the bucket.



### Step 9

Turn the main fabric right side out, make sure the footing corners are turned through.

### Step 10 (green bucket instructions on page 3)

Place the lining inside the bucket, match the seams and pin. You should have wrong sides together.

Stitch: straight stitch L: default W: 3.5 (CNP)

Take off the access box and stitch around the top of the bucket, line-up the fabric against the edge of the foot.





**Step 11**

Take a binding strip, fold in half with the right side out and press. Measure the binding around the top of the bucket, you should have an overlap of 1½" (4cm). Open out binding and press each end a ¼" (6mm). Then pin the binding along the top of the inside bucket, all raw edges are together. On the join, the binding should be overlapping. When positioned, stitch around the top of the bucket. Fold the binding out to the right-side and pin into place.

*Optional Ribbon:* Take the fluted ribbon and place it under the binding, so it is half under, half out.

Stitch around the bottom edge of the binding to secure both binding and fluted ribbon.

FINISH.



**GREEN BUCKET**

**Step 1**

Same as Pink Bucket.

**Step 2**

Attach even feed foot with guide.  
 Set guide at 20mm, use needle plate markings  
 Select triple straight stitch  
 Width: 3.5 (CNP) Length: 4.0mm  
 Using the fabric chalk mark your first 45° line on both main fabrics, mark the same start point on both. Stitch along the drawn line. Position the guide on the stitched line, stitch second line, with the guide running along the initial stitched line.



**Step 3**

When stitching all one way is done, mark the cross 45° line to create a cross hatch stitching pattern on the fabric. Stitch.



**Step 4 - 9**

Same as Pink Bucket.

**Step 10**

Place the lining inside the bucket, match the seams and pin. You should have wrong sides together. The lining is higher than the main fabric. Fold the top of the lining to the top of the bucket, then fold down again onto the bucket, fold is approx. 1" (2.5cm). Stitch around the edge of the binding.



FINISH.
