

Block - Ribbon & Sequin Foot



Fabric	Colour	Size (inches)	Preparation
Background Fabric	Button	2 ½ x 8 ½	Cut 2
Middle panel	Yellow	4 x 8 ½	
Ribbon	Assorted	12mm wide	Cut into 5 lengths of 9"

Needle Plate: Standard



Foot: Ribbon & Sequin RS



Thread: Teal



Needle: Janome Blue Tip



Stitch: Sewing Applications

> Optional Foot tab



> Ribbon & Sequin





1. Insert the ribbon into the lowest section of the foot. Position the foot in the middle of the block.



2. Stitch over the ribbon across the block



3. Lining up the edge of the foot with the previous ribbon



stitch



4. Attach a second ribbon with a different 5. Fill the block with rows of stitches and ribbons. Trim block to 8" square.



Block - Curved Seam & Topstitch

Background	Green	8 ½ x 8 ½		
Seaming sample	Yellow	8 ½ x 8 ½	Cut 2	
Seaming sample	Buttons	4 x 8 ½	Cut 2 (optional additional curve seam)

Needle Plate: Standard

Foot: Zigzag A & Satin Stitch F

Thread: Grey

Needle: Janome Sharp and Topstitch

Settings: Press Foot-up key






 Using a curved object such as a mug or bowl, draw a circular shape on the fabric



Place two pieces right sides together



. Sew on the line



4. Trim the inside back to ¼" seam allowance



5. Snip at intervals from the edge in towards the stitched line



5. Turn right sides out and press





7. Place the curved piece on top of the block



8. Change stitch to: Sewing Applications > Sewing tab > Top Stitch



Line up the edge of the curve with the inside of the foot.

Change needle to Topstitch needle



9. Sew a row of stitches around the curve



10. Line the edge of the curve with the slit in the foot



11. Sew a second row of stitches around the curve. Repeat process for additional curve sections. Trim block to 8" square.
