Needle Plate: Standard

Foot: Applique Foot

Thread: Teal

Needle: Organ Embroidery Anti Glue Needle





Stitch: Sewing Applications

> Quilting Tab

> Applique

> Blanket Stitch 1







Settings: Press Foot-up key



Press Cornering key





 Starting in a straighter section, line up the edge of the design with the slit in the foot



2. Start sewing slowly around the design, stopping when you get to a corner.

Turn the fabric to line up with the next direction.



Press the start-over key to start sewing from the beginning of the pattern





Continue to sew around the design, stopping when you get back to the start




Press the Reverse to lock off straight awayTrim block to 8" square.



NOTE: The images in this Block do not match the project. The instructions on applique are correct.

The foot pictured is a ultra-guide foot for when using speciality fabrics, like vinyl or leather. The ultra-glide foot does not stick, it glides over these fabrics.

Needle Plate: Standard



Foot: Satin Stitch F2



Thread: Pink & Teal



Needle: Twin Needle



Stitch: Function Menu







> Type in stitch: D13





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Settings: Press Twin Needle key





1. Manually Thread both needles, one at a time. Place stabiliser behind fabric



2. Line up edge of block with edge of foot Sew across the block



3. Select another decorative stitch, notice that you cannot choose 'greyed out' patterns. Sew across the block



4. Repeat for other stitch patterns, lining up the edge of the foot with the previous stitches



5. Fill the block with different rows of stitches. Trim block to 8" square.
