

Block – Pouch Zipper



Fabric	Colour	Size (inches)	Preparation
Background Fabric	Button	8 ½ x 8 ½	
Main Fabric	Green	4 ½ x 8 ½	Cut 2
Zipper	White	10"

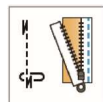
Needle Plate: Standard 	Foot: Zipper 	Thread: White 	Needle: Janome Sharp 12
Stitch: Sewing Applications 	> Sewing Tab 	> Pouch Zipper (page 2/3) 	



1. Place the zipper upside down onto one side of the main fabric. Line up the edge of the zipper with the long raw edge of the block



2. Select Sew back right side



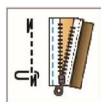
Line up the edge of the foot with the edge of the zipper and sew the seam



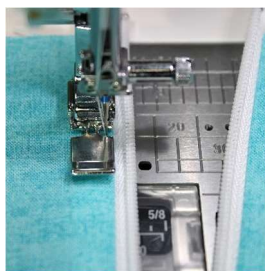
3. Place the other side of the zipper upside down onto the second piece of fabric
Make sure to align the raw edges



4. Select Sew back left side



Sew the zipper seam
Press back the seams



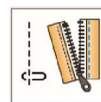
5. Select Top stitch front left side



Line up the edge of the foot with
the edge of the fold
Sew the length



6. Select Top stitch right side



Line up the edge of the foot with
the edge of the fold
Sew the length



7. Close the zipper half way



8. Place onto the block and stitch
around the outside to attach. Trim
block to 8" square.
