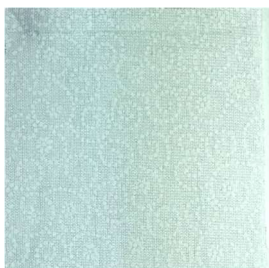


Block – Elongation

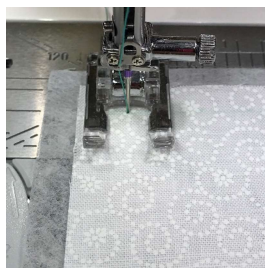


Fabric	Colour	Size (inches)	Preparation
Background	Black	8 ½ x 8 ½	
Stabiliser		8 ½ x 8 ½	Tear away
Notes:			

Needle Plate: Standard 	Foot: Satin Stitch F2 	Thread: Teal 	Needle: Janome Sharp 12
Stitch: Decorative Stitches 	> Satin (S) 	> Stitch #5 	
Settings: Press Adjust Key 	> Elongation Key 		



1. Draw a line across the top of the fabric ½" from the edge
Place stabiliser behind fabric



2. Line up the foot with the raw edges of the block
Needle position lined up with the drawn line
Start sewing the first pattern and stop after a few stitches



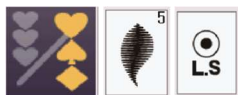
3. Press the Auto-Lock button, the light will start to flash



Continue to sew, the machine will complete the pattern and finish the stitch



4. Press the Program key > stitch 5 > locking stitch



Press the curser until the stitch is blue



5. Increase the elongation to x2



Line up the edge of the foot with the previous pattern and sew from the drawn line



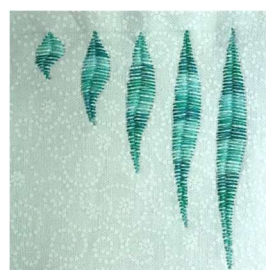
6. Repeat for elongation x3



7. Repeat for elongation x4



8. Repeat for elongation x5. Rotate block and repeat on each side or as desired.



9. Remove stabiliser, trim block to 8" square.
