


## Block – Decorative Stitching / Mirage



Fabric	Colour	Size (inches)	Preparation			
Background	Black	8 ½ x 8 ½				
Stabiliser		8 ½ x 8 ½	Tear away			
Notes:						

Needle Plate: Standard



Foot: Satin Stitch F2



Thread: Teal



Needle: Janome Sharp 12



**Stitch:** Decorative Stitches



> Heirloom









 Line up the edge of the fabric near the edge of the foot



2. Stitch across the block



Line up the foot with the previous row of stitches



4. Select stitch H40



Sew across the block



5. Select stitch Q49



Sew across the block



6. Continue to sew different stitches to fill the block. Trim block to 8" square.



## Block - Shell Tuck / Professional Plate & Foot




Fabric	Colour	Size (inches)	Preparation
Background	Green	8 ½ x 8 ½	
Fabric	Black	8 x 8	Cut into two HST
Shell Tuck	Red	1 x 20	Press in half lengthwise
Binding	Button	2 ½ x 20	Press in half lengthwise

#### **Shell Tuck**





1. Fold fabric strip in half lengthwise



 Line the folded edge of the white fabric strip with the split in the F foot so that the needle clears the fabric on the right-hand side



3. Sew along the length of the strip



 Cut in half and place one piece on either side of the corner of quilt wadding, raw edges together Glue baste in place





5. Change the needle plate Press the Lockout key


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6. Press needle plate release key, the foot and needle plate will raise automatically









8. Replace with the HP Professional plate

### **Professional Binding**

Needle Plate: HP Professional



**Foot:** HP2 Professional AcuFeed Flex foot



Thread: White




Needle: Janome Red Tip



Stitch: Utility U1




Settings: Press Foot Up Key (Pivot)




Press Dual Feed Key (Acufeed)







 Place the start of the binding strip over the shell tuck pieces
Line up all the raw edges to the edge of foot
Start to sew ¼" seam allowance



 STOP ¼" before the end of the quilt corner, use the markings on the foot and needle plate as guides



Rotate quilt 45° clockwise



4. Stitch out towards the corner point



5. Cut threads




6. Fold the binding up against the diagonal stitch line

# **JANOME**



 Then fold it straight down towards the second side, lining up the raw edges



8. Sew from the edge of the fabric



Finger press the binding out over the edge of the quilt and around to the back



10. On the front, pin along the ditch between the shell tuck and binding to hold in place



11. Stitch in the ditch to secure the binding in place



Pivot the quilt at the corner



13. Stitch to the end of the binding



Centre onto the pink backing square



15. Stitch along the top edge 2-3mm from the raw edges. Trim block to 8" square.
